**COMMISSIONER'S REPORT – TOWN BOARD ACTION: Bicycle Trail:** Discussions are in progress to include the Bruce Vento Regional Trail as part of the United States Bicycle Route 41 from St. Paul to the Canadian Border. The thought is not to build new trails but to determine how bicycles can get to Grand Portage. Ramsey County Parks and Recreation is planning to submit an application for the 2016 Regional Solicitation for federal funding. The application will address the extension of the trail from Buerkle Road to Highway 96. They are soliciting letters of support from neighboring communities for the preliminary design and submission of the application. There will be an open house at the White Bear Lake City Hall on June 9, 2016 from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. The consultants will present the overall plan and where trails are designated in this area. **Renewal By Anderson:** The Town Board approved a solicitor's license for Pat Prokosch and two others to solicit in the Township following Town regulations per ordinance. **Hobby Kennel Licenses:** The Town Board approved a number of Hobby Kennel Licenses recently. None of the other six contract communities requires a hobby kennel license for three dogs, and the Town Board is discussing the Town's current process.
