YARD WASTE BAG LAW

REMINDER - You can no longer use standard plastic bags for leaves and grass clippings. Residents are required to put yard waste out for pickup in compostable bags – either paper bags or compostable plastic bags. Allied Waste, the Township's Refuse Hauler, provides curb side leaf pickup on your regular pick up day. Residents can also haul yard waste to the Ramsey County site located on Sherwood Road off County Road J.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS

WASTE - Ramsey County offers year-round Household Hazardous Waste collection at Bay West, Inc., #5 Empire Drive, St. Paul. Accepted items include lawn and garden chemicals, used oil and filters, cleaning products, paints and stains, items containing mercury, etc.



DO NOT TRASH ELECTRONICS - It

is illegal to place any item that contains a CRT (cathode ray tube) in the garbage, which includes televisions and computer monitors.



Did you know: Batteries (non-rechargeable alkaline, heavy duty, and zinc air batteries) may be placed in the trash. They no longer contain hazardous material.



Medicines from households, including prescription, over the counter, vitamins, supplements, pet medicines, are accepted year round at the following sites: Sheriff's Patrol Station, 1411 Paul Kirkwold Drive, Arden Hills; Law Enforcement Center, 425 Grove Street, St. Paul (M-F 8 am – 4 pm; closed on federal holidays).
