WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS IN PLACE

Vehicles are prohibited from parking on Township streets

between the hours of 2 am – 6 am, from November 1 – April 1. In addition, on-street parking is not allowed during any time of the day after a snowfall of 1" or more, until the plowing and snow removal operations are complete.



SHOVELING, PLOWING, SNOW BLOWING, ETC.

It is a violation of Township Ordinance to shovel, snow blow or plow snow or ice into any public street, alley, sidewalk, improved trail, or parking area. These regulations

facilitate the orderly removal of snow for public

safety, and help us provide our residents with more efficient delivery of public services.

As snow banks build up, fire hydrants along streets can become buried. Your

assistance in keeping snow cleared away from the Township's hydrants is appreciated.
