ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

Animal Control services for the Township are provided by the



Ramsey County Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office approaches animal control with an emphasis on education and finding neighborhood friendly solutions to issues such as barking dogs. If a stray animal can't be returned home, it will be brought to Hillcrest Animal Hospital, 1320 East County Road D, Maplewood (651-484-7211).
