The **Township Election** will be held on **Tuesday, March 12, 2013**. Electors will vote for one Town Board Supervisor for a term of three years, and also vote to decide if the Township should move the Annual Township Election from March to November in even numbered years, to coincide with the Federal and State Elections. **Who filed for Town Board?** Town Board Supervisor Ed Prudhon is running unopposed for re-election. Ed served on the Planning Commission for 21 years, and has served on the Town Board since 5/16/11.



**What Happens If the Township changes to November Elections?** The Township would share the ballot with County, State and Federal elections.

(Currently the Town's March elections focus solely on Township issues.) Town Board Elections would be held in even numbered years, versus every year. Town Board terms would be extended from three years to four years. Two Town Board seats, which is a majority on our three-member Town Board, would be elected at the same time every four years.

If moved to November, could elections change back to March? Yes, however, the Township must conduct at least two November Elections before returning to March Elections can be considered.
