HALLOWEEN Safety Tips

Add reflective tape to costumes and candy bags. Masks should not block eyesight. Carry a flashlight with fresh batteries. Only go to familiar neighborhoods with well-lit streets and to houses with a front light on. Never enter a home or car for a treat. Parents should always accompany young children, and walk them to the door. Older children should stay in a group, carry a cell phone, and communicate their route. Examine all treats before eating. Remind children to call 911 if they get lost, and to say "NO" in a loud voice, kick and scream, etc., if someone tries to get them to go somewhere with them.
