**Check your Smoke/CO detectors monthly!** Every time you change your clocks, change your batteries. **Both**

**smoke and carbon monoxide detectors have expiration dates.** Most detectors should be replaced 7-10 years after the manufacturer date located on back of detector.



**Recreational Fire Regulations:** Cannot exceed 2' in diameter and 3' in height; must be setback more than 15' from nearest structure and 25' from nearest motor

vehicle; use fire pit or non-combustible fire ring; use only clean wood (no yard waste or refuse); extinguish immediately if generating nuisance smoke; not allowed between midnight and 6:00 am; must have constant adult supervision and means to control fire (garden hose).



Residents experiencing a **sewer backup** should first try to determine if it is within their household

plumbing. If only some drains are affected, the problem is usually within the home, and a plumber should be called. If all drains are working and water is backing up a floor drain, contact the Township Public Works Department, who will check the sewer main line for blockages. Residents and businesses are responsible for the portion of pipe (the sanitary sewer service line), that runs from their home/business to the sanitary sewer main line. Tree roots and collapsed service lines are the most common problems with sanitary sewer service lines. Please notify the Township Public Works Department of any sanitary sewer service line cleaning and/or repair.
