SNOW RELATED SAFETY:



For your children's safety, do not allow them to build **snow structures or tunnels** in the snow banks at the end of driveways, in cul-de-sacs, or along roadways. Snowplows may pass by at any time to remove snow or make space for future snow events.



Shoveling Guidelines – Residents are not allowed to “throw” snow onto neighboring properties (without permission), or into public streets or right-of-ways.



Keep Fire Hydrants Clear – Please shovel out around fire hydrants after each snowfall. If the Fire Department has to locate a hydrant under the snow, they lose precious time needed to fight fires.



Garbage & Recycling Containers – Do not place containers in the street where they can be hit and damaged by snowplows.
