

SATURDAY, JUNE 14, 2014, CLEAN-UP DAY 7:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m., Otter Lake School, 1401 County Road H2. Appliances, Car Batteries, Tires, Mattresses, Furniture, Carpeting, Lawn Mowers (fluids drained), Bagged or Bundled Building Materials (under 30 lbs), Televisions & Electronic Equipment accepted. Ramsey County will also collect household hazardous waste items. This is a FREE drop off for TOWNSHIP Residents (ID required).



OUTSIDE BURNING REGULATIONS SMALL RECREATIONAL FIRES (2' x 3') ARE ALLOWED IN THE TOWNSHIP. No yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, small brush); refuse, oil, rubber

or similar smoke producing material. FIRE MUST BE EXTINGUISHED IMMEDIATELY IF GENERATING SMOKE THAT BECOMES A NUISANCE TO NEARBY PROPERTIES. Visit Township web site for complete list of open burning regulations.



DOGS AND CATS NOT PERMITTED TO RUN AT LARGE Pets must be effectively restrained within a fenced in yard, an electronic fence with signage, or controlled by a leash. Owners are required to clean up after their pets on all public

and private property. Dog owners must prevent nuisance barking. Dogs are allowed to run at large within a designated off-leash dog area. OTTER LAKE ROAD OFF-LEASH DOG AREA, 5750 Otter Lake Road, is an entirely fenced-in 10 acre site. Visit Ramsey County Parks & Recreation web site for more information.
