



1st EVER NOVEMBER TOWN BOARD SUPERVISOR ELECTION - Remember to cast your vote on November 4th – two Town Board seats up for election.



WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1ST – No vehicle may park on any road or street in the Township between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m., from November 1st through April 1st, or any time after a snowfall of one or more inches, until the road is cleared curb to curb.



HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS – Always go trick-or-treating with a responsible adult; walk, don't run; ensure masks do not obscure vision; avoid costumes that are too long as they might cause tripping; look both ways before crossing the street; never go inside a stranger's house or vehicle; wear a bright costume, if your costume is dark, add reflective tape or glow bracelets so others can see you; stick to the sidewalk unless you are crossing the street; only go to houses that have at least one light on; never eat unwrapped candy or food, make sure your parents take a look at your candy before eating it.



OUTSIDE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE STORAGE – Boats, snowmobiles, travel trailers, campers, and antique cars may be stored in rear or side yards if they are currently licensed and operable, and if the combined outside area for parking of all recreational vehicles and trailers does not exceed 300 square feet.
