**Why is the Salt Colored that is Applied to the Town Streets?** The salt is colored for a few reasons. 1) The salt is treated with a liquid that allows the salt to work at lower temperatures; 2) The salt adheres to the street better and leads to a reduction in amount of salt used; and 3) It allows the operator to see the material as it is being applied so the operator can make adjustments to the application equipment and keep the materials on the street.
