DON'T RECYCLE PLASTIC BAGS AT THE CURB – Republic, the Town's waste and recycling hauler, is requesting residents to no longer place plastic bags in your recycling cart. Sorting of the bags has become problematic at the haulers recycling facility. The bags have been getting stuck in

HOW TO RECYCLE YOUR OLD CELL PHONES – Reusing or recycling cell phones conserves materials, prevents air and water pollution, and reduces greenhouse gas emissions from

manufacturing and processing. Did you know only 10% of cell phones are recycled? According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, if Americans recycled the approximately 130 million cell phones that are disposed of annually, we could have enough energy to power 24,000 homes in a year. Here are three easy, earth-friendly ways to dispose of unwanted cell phones:

- Many charitable organizations collect used cell phones for fundraising. To find a cell phone donation program, search the Internet for “cell phone donation”.
- Most cell phone manufacturers and wireless service providers offer take-back programs at their stores or by mail.
- You can also sell your cell on eBay or Craigslist.
