Are You A Considerate Neighbor?

Hydrant Flushing to Begin –

Within the next three to four weeks White Bear Township Public Works will begin to flush hydrants and water mains throughout the Township. Some residents may

experience discoloration in the water. Residents can open their lowest level faucet to clear the



line. It is not advisable to wash clothes if the water is discolored.



• **Utility Bill Due Dates** – Township Utility bills are sent out quarterly and are due on the following dates: March 25th, June 25th, September 25th, &

December 25th

• **Delinquent Utility Bills** – Just a reminder if you owe any past due amounts on your utility bills you have until September 25, 2015 to pay them to avoid having the past due amounts sent to Ramsey County for payment with your property taxes in 2016.

• **When Moving** – Please call the Township's Utility Billing Department at 651-747-2754 before you move to schedule a water meter read to insure an accurate final bill.

• **Stains from Discolored Water** – if you have any stains on clothing, bathroom fixtures or in your washer due to brown/colored water, the Township offers free bottles of "Rust-Go" to its residents. This additive removes stains and discoloration.
