



WATER EFFICIENCY REBATES ARE GOING FAST – ACT TODAY

–Water Efficiency Rebates are still available to White Bear Township utility customers who replace existing products with specified water efficient products now through June 30, 2017 or until the remaining \$6,143.00 is depleted. Residents can claim 100 percent of the cost of the item, up to a maximum of \$150 for Energy Star washers; \$200 for WaterSense toilets; and \$200 for irrigation controllers. HELP STOMP OUT CRIME –

- **Keep your Garage Door Closed** – a closed door keeps the opportunistic thief from helping themselves to your valuables. Close the door whenever you are out of sight, this includes while mowing the lawn or taking a walk around the block.
- **Be an Engaged Neighbor** – when you see or hear anything suspicious please call 911 & Sheriff's deputies will respond to check it out. Calling immediately is the most effective way to help keep your neighborhood safe.
- **Lock Your Car Doors** – valuables taken from vehicles left unlocked is a common occurrence, remember lock your doors!!
- **Parents - Curfew Times are the Same County Wide** – help protect our youth from becoming a victim or getting in trouble with the law. Obey the curfew. Juveniles age 15 & younger need to be home by 10 p.m. every night of the week & those age 16-17 need to be home by midnight. Curfews apply to any public space, such as streets, parks, highways, & schools. Curfew also applies to public establishments such as movie theatres, restaurants, & bowling alleys. Teens accompanied by a parent or guardian may be out after these hours & there are other exceptions.



WANT MOSQUITO INFORMATION? – The Metropolitan Mosquito Control District provides a wide variety of mosquito/fly/tick information. Everything from helicopter routes, spraying times & days, types of chemicals used, & hints on how to identify & rid your home of mosquito breeding sites.
