TUESDAY, DECEMBER 6TH SPECIAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING

- Residents are invited to attend White Bear Township's Special Town Budget Meeting being held at 7 p.m., Tuesday,

December 6th at Heritage Hall located at 4200 Otter Lake Road. Similar to the Annual Town Meeting held in March, this is a meeting of the residents, where those in attendance will approve by vote the amount to be levied for the 2017 property tax & provide a recommendation of the Town's 2017 operating budget to the Town Board after a presentation from Town staff. Staff will also answer any questions residents have regarding the 2017 property tax levy & budget. At the time of this publication the 2017 operating budget is proposed to increase 3.91% to \$3,898,432 & the property tax levy is proposed to increase 2.93% to \$3,898,432. ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT NEAR YOU THIS WINTER - Help keep your neighborhood safe this winter by

adopting a fire hydrant near your home & keep it clear of snow build-up all season long so that it is easily visible in the event of an emergency.



DO NOT DEPOSIT SNOW IN THE STREET - Shoveling snow into public streets is prohibited by State law, please help keep our streets clear of snow snakes & snow piles during the winter.



REMINDER - PLEASE PLACE YOUR GARBAGE & RECYCLING CONTAINERS IN YOUR DRIVEWAY - Garbage & recycling containers that are placed in the street run the risk of being damaged by snow from passing snowplows.



CHECK YOUR MAILBOX POST - It is a good idea to check your mailbox post before the snow flies, if it wiggles, seems weak, or you can almost push it over yourself, now is the time to repair it. Weak posts can be more susceptible to damage by such things as snow rolling off of a snowplow blade or the mailman sliding into it.
