**REMINDER** – No person shall trap any animal within the confines of any green (open) space in White Bear Township unless such person is:

- Acting on behalf of the Town as part of an authorized wildlife management program
- Duly licensed by the State of Minnesota pursuant to Minnesota Statutes or
- Such person is acting on behalf of Ramsey County.

Using less water is important for several reasons:

- It takes a considerable amount of energy to deliver and treat the water you use every day. According to the EPA, letting your faucet run for five minutes uses about as much energy as letting a 60-watt light bulb run for 14 hours!
- Water has a high heat capacity, meaning it takes a lot of energy to make hot water.
- Only 3% of the earth's surface water is drinkable. Water is a precious resource that we should not waste!
