RAMSEY COUNTY YARD WASTE SITES NOW OPEN

– The yard waste site in White Bear Township resumed its regular hours for the season on March 26th, they are: Mon/Wed/Friday – 11:00-7:00, Sat/Sun – 9:00-5:00, please have your I.D. with you. The Township site accepts leaves, grass & non-woody plants, trees & shrubs, but no stumps. They also accept source separated organics (food waste, food tainted paper or cardboard) & non-recyclable paper and/or cardboard. RECAP - White Bear Township held its Annual Town Meeting on March 13th.

The Annual Town Meeting is true grassroots government where residents in attendance vote to approve a resident to moderate the meeting, approve the previous year's meeting minutes, approve the meeting agenda, & approve a property tax levy. This year's meeting was moderated by James Linn & had approximately 40 residents in attendance. County Board Member Blake Huffman & County Attorney John Choi provided residents with updates on County activities that have or will affect the Township. Ramsey County Sheriff Jack Serier provided an update on the Sheriff's Office activities. Residents were updated on the Town's finances from the Town Finance Officer, Tom Kelly, & then voted to approve the 2019 preliminary property tax levy of \$3,868,742.
