New Absentee and Early Voting Locations for White Bear Township and Gem Lake Residents - Absentee voting begins June 29, 2018 for the Primary Election. You are able to vote before Election Day by the following ways:

Vote by Mail - Ramsey County Elections will administer all mail voting. Voters interested in receiving a ballot by mail will be able to apply online at www.mnvotes.org or you can submit a hard copy of the application to Ramsey County Elections Office, PO Box 64098, St. Paul, MN 55164.

In-Person Absentee Voting - (Voters place ballot in a secure ballot envelope). Ramsey County Elections will administer in-person absentee voting for the state primary at the Ramsey County Offices, 90 Plato Blvd West, St. Paul from June 29 through August 6. For the state general election, you are able to in-person absentee vote at 90 Plato Blvd West, St. Paul and at the Arden Hills Public Works Building, 1425 Paul Kirkwold Drive, Arden Hills from September 21 through October 29. All Ramsey County voters will be able to vote at these locations.

Early Voting - (Ballot is placed in ballot counter) Ramsey County Elections will administer early voting for the state primary from August 7 through August 13 and for the state general election from October 30 through November 5. Early voting will take place at the following locations. All Ramsey County voters will be able to cast their early voting ballot at any of these locations:

City of St. Paul

- Ramsey County Elections Office
- Highland Park Community Center
- Martin Luther King Recreation Center
- Ramsey County Public Works Building
- Arlington Hills Community Center

Suburban Ramsey County

- Ramsey County Libraries - WBL, Maplewood, Shoreview & Roseville
- Como Park Historic Streetcar Station in Arden Hills
- St. Anthony City Hall

Early voting hours at the Ramsey County Elections Office are as follows:
Monday 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Tuesday through Friday 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

There will also be extended hours for the State General Election as follows:
Sunday, Nov. 4th 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Early voting hours at all other locations will be as follows:

- Monday 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- Tuesday through Friday 12:00 noon - 6:00 p.m.
- Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

IT'S FIREWORKS TIME - KEEP IT LEGAL & KEEP IT SAFE - With the 4th of July nearing, please keep in mind the following:



Keep it legal - permitted fireworks include sparklers, cones & tubes that emit sparks, novelty items like snakes & party poppers. Prohibited fireworks include, but are not limited to firecrackers, bottle rockets, missiles, roman candles, mortars & shells.

Keep it Safe - Read & understand fireworks directions, read caution labels before igniting

- Use fireworks only with close adult supervision & keep fireworks away from children - sparklers alone burn at 1800o
- Never aim or throw fireworks at a person, animal, building, vehicle, wooded area or flammable items
- Stay away from failed fireworks ("duds") for an extended amount of time to make sure they don't ignite
- Check wind direction before lighting fireworks or avoid having it blow into trees, onto house roofs, fields, etc.
