OVER THE COURSE OF THE SUMMER, 100-150 inspections occur at outdoor fairs & festivals in suburban Ramsey County! The Ramsey County Health Department inspectors visit each of the onsite food vendors, checking that all employees are: washing their hands; not working while ill; cooking meats to the proper temperature; keeping food at proper hot & cold holding temperatures; protecting food from sources of contamination. These inspections help ensure the foods you eat at these events are prepared & served safely.

HELPFUL TOWNSHIP ORDINANCES & TIPS AT-A-GLANCE -

- **Garbage Can Storage** – cans shall be kept up by your home & must only be placed out by the street behind the curb on the day of pick-up & are to be removed by 10:00 p.m. the same day
- **Grass Clippings** – grass clippings or leaves should not be put in the street because it will eventually end up in nearby streams, lakes & rivers. Decomposing plant material in the water encourages the growth of harmful aquatic plants & algae
- **Sheds** – a permit is required if you want to put up a shed
- **Certification of Delinquent Utility Bills to Your Taxes** – it's the time of year that delinquent utility bills are certified to taxes. If your account is past due please plan to bring it current before October 15th. If you have questions on your account please call 651.747.2754
- **Election Signs** – election or campaign signs are permitted on private property only with owner consent. Such signs must be removed within 10 calendar days following the election
- **Moving?** – please call the Township's utility billing department at 651.747.2754 before you move, to schedule a water meter read which will insure an accurate final bill or visit the Township's website at www.whitebeartownship.org & click on the "Doing Business" tab / "Utility Billing", "Establishing or Disconnecting Services" & complete the Utility Account Request Form to insure a meter read is performed
