



**WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS BEGAN NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup>** – No vehicle may park on any road or street in the Township between the hours of 2 a.m. & 6 a.m. from November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup>, or any time after a snowfall of one or more inches until the road is cleared curb to curb.



**CAMPER & BOAT STORAGE REGULATIONS BEGAN NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup>**

– Outside storage of boats, travel trailers, campers & camping buses has been changed, parking on or adjacent to a driveway is only allowed from April 1<sup>st</sup> through November 1<sup>st</sup>. Snowmobiles may be parked on or adjacent to driveways from November 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>.



**STREET SWEEPING TO BEGIN** – The Township’s Public Works Department will begin sweeping the streets of the Township on November 13<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting.

**RECYCLING AT HOME REMINDERS** – Empty containers & give them a quick

rinse; keep recyclables loose in your recycling cart, do not bag them; plastic bags are not being collected at this time. Remember the following items ARE RECYCLABLE: dishwashing bottles; glass food & beverage bottles & jars; ketchup & salad dressing bottles; metal food & beverage cans; milk & juice cartons & jugs; plastic water, pop & juice bottles, soup, broth & wine cartons; clear fruit & vegetable

containers; margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese & other tubs; yogurt pudding & fruit cups – no foil lids; cardboard cans (hips, nuts, oatmeal); cereal, cracker, pasta & other pantry boxes can be included in household recycling; delivery pizza boxes – no food or grease; food boxes from the refrigerator; paper towel tubers; shampoo, soap & lotion bottles; tissue boxes; toilet paper tubes; toothpaste boxes & other toiletry boxes; fabric softener boxes; laundry detergent bottles.
