PUBLIC WORKS NEEDS YOUR ASSISTANCE

- Proper placement of your trash/recycling containers is simple, but extremely important to achieve efficient street maintenance operations. Trash/recycling

containers must NOT be placed on street surfaces. The containers should be placed in the cleared driveway area or an area of the boulevard cleared of snow to allow for their placement up to two feet behind the curb when waiting for pickup. This allows snowplows to clear the streets from curb to curb.

BOULEVARD TREE TRIMMING TO BEGIN – The Township’s Public Works Department will be pruning boulevard trees during the next few months. Boulevard trees are those typically within 15 feet from the back of the curb/edge of



the street. The trees will be pruned to remove branches that hang low over the street surface or the sidewalk/trail including dead or broken branches & in some instances branches may be removed from the side of the tree away from the street in order to maintain the symmetry or balance of the tree’s crown. GO GREEN WITH YOUR WHITE BEAR TOWNSHIP UTILITY BILL

- Would you like to receive your quarterly utility bill via email instead of by snail mail? e-Bills are now available to White Bear Township

Utility Billing Customers! It is easy to sign up. Go to www.whitebeartownship.org & click on the Online Utility Billing icon located on the front page of our website. If you are a first time user, you will need to register your account. You will need your



account number including the dashes (i.e. 01-00000-00) & the last dollar amount you paid. If you need either of these items, please call the Utility Billing Department at 651.747.2754. If you are already registered, just log into your account and on the right hand side under Online Services, click on “Sign up for e-Billing”. It is that simple. Then each quarter you will receive your utility bill via email from Utilitybilling@whitebeartownship.org. There will also be a link in the email to click on for the insert that went out in the mailed bills.

Take it one-step further & you can pay on-line with a debit or credit card! You can set this up to be a reoccurring payment or a one-time payment. If you want to have a reoccurring payment, you must register your account.
