**Recycle these items in your cart.
No bags or sorting required!**

Paper

Recycle

- Mail, office and school papers
- Phonebooks
- Magazines, newspaper and inserts
- Shredded paper in closed paper bags

Boxes:

- Pop and beer boxes
- Cereal, cracker, shoe and gift boxes
- Toothpaste, medication and other toiletry boxes
- Cardboard and pizza boxes

NO: Paper towel or toilet paper tubes
Refrigerated or frozen food boxes
Napkins, paper plates or cups
Tissue or wrapping paper



Cartons

Recycle

Rinse.

- Milk cartons
- Juice boxes
- Soup, broth and wine cartons

NO: Paper or Styrofoam™ egg cartons



Metal

Recycle

Rinse.

- Food and beverage cans
- Decorative tins and pie tins

NO: Paint cans or containers that held hazardous substances such as paint thinner and automotive fluids
Aerosol cans
Scrap metal



Plastics

Recycle

Rinse and leave caps on.

Bottles and Jugs:

- Water, soda and juice bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
- Dishwashing liquids and detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles

Containers:

- Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
- Margarine, cottage cheese, and other containers
- Transparent "To-Go" containers
- Lettuce, berries and other plastic produce containers

NO: Plastic bags or film
Motor oil or antifreeze bottles



Glass

Recycle

Rinse and remove caps and lids

- Bottles and jars

NO: Window glass or mirrors
Ceramics or pottery
Drinking glasses or cookware
