**MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Anderson, Griffin, LeBlanc, Lee, Linn, Timmers: Town Board Liaison: Prudhon; Staff Liaison: Short: Guest: Commander Rich Clark, Ramsey County Sheriff's Office; Josh Wickander: Lucy's Burgers.

Absent: Brueckner and Pozzini-Stedman with notice.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** LeBlanc moved approval of the agenda with the following amendment: Add 9A) Lucy's Burgers. Griffin seconded. Ayes all.

**APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY 1, 2018 MEETING MINUTES:** LeBlanc moved approval of the February 1, 2018 meeting minutes. Anderson seconded. Ayes all.

**CONSENT AGENDA:** LeBlanc moved approval of the Consent Agenda as follows: 4A) Receive Animal Control Reports; 4B) Receive Ramsey County Sheriff's Reports; 4C) Receive Sheriff's Contract Group Minutes; 4D) Receive White Bear Lake Fire Department Reports. Timmers seconded. Ayes all.

**COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: Northeast Youth & Family Services:** The Clerk reported that Jerry Hromatka, Director, NYFS provided an annual update to the Town Board on services provided by NYFS to the Township. NYFS serves all ages but their main population is 5-21 year olds. There are 4000 youth and families who receive services. The budget has been at \$3.3 million for several years. With changes in funding and programs they have been able to maintain that level of funding. Their three main program areas are mental health, day treatment, and community services. Mental health services are provided in school-based, clinic based, and in home. They have therapists in 19 school buildings and they work very closely with school personnel. Clinic based services are provided at clinics in White Bear Lake and the main clinic in Shoreview. In-home services are provided to deal with people in their homes to reduce the barriers for them to receive the services that they need. Community Services focuses on academics, employment, life skills, and citizenship which is being a part of something other than themselves. The day treatment program is for kids with severe mental health issues. Out of school program is a special ed program where therapists are provided to help with their education. Support from NYFS for the Township includes services for all residents for mental health services, diversions, and senior chore programs regardless of their ability to pay. The kids come with more difficult and more complex issues than five years ago. Another benefit is effective workforce opportunities for the kids. In the senior chore program kids are matched with seniors and it becomes a first time job for them. All the kids go through the diversion program as first time offenders, or low level offenders, and go through community services. The kids say that they see themselves differently when they help others. The stigma for receiving mental health help is going away and more families are receiving the help that they need. One of the things that NYSF is understanding more and more is trauma. Trauma is the result of the brain that does not develop in children who are in an ongoing toxic environment. NYSF uses evidence-based practices. The research shows that this works for people so NYFS staff needs to be trained in that area. NYFS tries to raise funds to deal with helping a person pay high deductibles and high out of pocket expenses. They will help

Township residents who have a high deductible to come in and NYFS will help them pay for the service. The stigma of mental health is diminishing and people are demanding more mental health services.

**COMMANDER RICH CLARK, RAMSEY COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE:** Deputy Clark stated that they are seeing mental health issues in people that are more violent. They have initiated a new program in the jail that deals with mental health crisis. There is special screening for someone with mental health issues. The RCSO is getting more resources to deal with this matter. He stated that they try to direct juveniles to a diversion program. Mark Griffin, who sees juvenile cases in the Hennepin County Prosecutors Office, stated that many of their cases are referred to diversion. He stated that the schools can be asked to help. Deputy Clark stated that they are seeing an uptick in juvenile cases. They also find alternative schools for the kids. The Clerk noted that School District 916, located at the Bellaire School, provides an environment for people who cannot learn in a conventional school.

The Clerk noted that the City of Gem Lake has changed the law enforcement provider from the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office to the White Bear Lake Police Department. The Ramsey County Sheriff's Office has contracted with the City of Falcon Heights for law enforcement. Deputy Clark stated that they are in the process of rebuilding a relationship with law enforcement for that community. They have made a lot of effort to address response time in Falcon Heights.

Deputy Clark reported that the RCSO has 100 new hires for both detention and sworn deputies. They have a total of 450 detention officers and sworn deputies. He reported that he will be moving to the Special Investigations Unit. His position as Patrol Commander will be replaced with two new deputies. The Township's new point of contact in the Patrol Division will be forwarded to the Town Clerk.

There was general discussion regarding an active shooter training event which occurred in the Township. The RCSO trains in this area. Their position is that the first officer on the scene can eliminate the threat and not have to wait for SWAT to arrive. There was discussion regarding what can be done about problem rental houses in the Township. Deputy Clark stated that the deputies work within Town Ordinances. They follow the protocol and citations are given if appropriate. In the case of rental property, the owner has to talk to the Sheriff Deputy. Once that contact with the owner has been made the owner can be cited. If there are persistent problems the Town can revoke the rental license for the property. It was suggested that other communities be surveyed to see what they do with rental properties. The Clerk ask staff to collect information. It was recommended that the Town Board look into regulations to address calls for service and other nuisance calls for rental properties.

Deputy Clark reviewed the Calls for Service for 2016-2017 for the Township. In 2016 the Township had 3,792 calls for service. In 2017 there were 3,837 calls for service. There were 45 more calls in 2017 than in 2016 which resulted in a 1.17% increase. For all the contact communities Traffic stops are the highest calls for service (2016 had 6,656; in 2017 there were 6,581). The second highest calls for service are Assist Medical Agency. In 2016 there were 3,977 and in 2017 there were 4,437. In descending order calls for service were: Suspicious

Activity; Parking Complaint; Assist Citizen; Police Proactive Visit; Disorderly Conduct; Accident Property Damage; Assist Fire Agency; Welfare Check. In White Bear Township Police Proactive Visits have doubled since 2016. These calls provide a Sheriff's presence. Commander Clark was thanked for his participation in the meeting.

**TOWNSHIP DAY FESTIVAL – SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2018:** There was discussion regarding the Public Safety Commissions' presence at the Township Day event. The Park Board has extended an invitation for the commissions to participate. It was noted that the PSC has determined to not participate in the Otter Lake Elementary School's Carnival this year. They decided that their involvement in the Township Day event would involve more Township residents than at the carnival. It was the consensus that the Public Safety Commission, along with the Sheriff's Office, have a booth. There will be further discussion at next month's meeting regarding auctioning a bike. Lee will let Park Board member, Pat Lee know of the PSC's consensus to participate in the Township Day event.

**LIAISON REPORTS:** In response to a question if an alternate member could have a liaison position. It was the consensus that there is no problem having an alternate holding that position. Mark Griffin volunteered to be the liaison to the Sheriff's Office. At present, if there are any liaison reports they will be provided as available. The matter of Liaisons will be continued.

**LUCY'S BURGERS – TENT PARTY REQUEST:** Josh Wickander attended the meeting to discuss Lucy's Burgers' request for a tent party event near their first anniversary date. They are considering a June event. They would like to set up a 20' x 30' party tent in the parking lot adjacent to Lucy's Burgers side entrance. The tent will have 2 closed sides and crowd control barriers or fences to ensure people enter and exit the event properly. No alcohol is allowed outside of the tent or the restaurant or the walk between the two areas. This will be a controlled entrance and exit of the event. They will staff the gates with off-duty police officers to ensure that everyone is of age. They will card all who attend and issue bracelets required to purchase a drink at this event. This is a 21 year old plus event and ID is required by all. Lucy's will offer a shuttle bus service to attendees who don't want to drive to and from, or rides home to those who need them. They will have additional security to ensure things don't get out of hand. They will have temporary beer trailers that have a selection of tap beers and temporary bars set up inside the tent. There will be a clean-up crew that starts at the end of the event to make sure all litter and garbage is removed immediately following the event and the grounds are clear and left better than it was when the event started. Portable toilets will be set up as well to keep the crowds and alcohol consumption in one area and prevent people from wandering outside the designated areas with alcohol. There will be 2 to 3 bands that play starting around noon and ending at 10:00 p.m. with breaks in between so the next band can set up and crowds can rotate in and out. There will be DJ music when the bands are not playing. To make this happen they need to have their liquor license extended from 11:00 a.m. to midnight to include the tent they set up in the parking lot area. Last call in the tent is at 10:30 p.m. All drinks are collected and removed before 11:00 p.m. to ensure that they can wind down the event peacefully. People who wish to hang out for a bit or are waiting for a ride home can wait inside Lucy's. That bar closes at 1:00 a.m. They will purchase any additional liability insurance if needed.

The Town Attorney has reviewed a temporary liquor license for the tent party. Retail alcoholic beverage licenses are only effective for the premises specified in the approved license application according to MN Statute §340A.410, subd. 7. This means that Lucy's present license limits them to serving intoxicating beverages to the space described in their license application. The statute allow for issuance of temporary on-sale license (MN statute §340A.404, subd 10. This license would be conditional. It may only be issued to a club or charitable, religious or other non-profit organization existing for at least three years; a political committee registered under Section 10A.14 or a state university. There is no provision in the statute to issue a temporary license to a private entity. There is one additional exception. A municipality may authorize the holder of a retail on-sale intoxicating liquor license to sell off-premises at a community festival. Only municipalities and the counties are allowed to issue liquor licenses. The definition of municipality is limited to cities and counties which mean that the Town cannot issue a liquor license directly. Instead the license must come from Ramsey County. However, the county cannot issue a liquor license unless the Town consents. Unless Lucy's can find a club, charitable, religious or other non-profit organization to apply for the temporary license, it cannot sell intoxicating beverages in the tent as planned.

Josh Wickander stated that they will have lights inside the tent, but not outside. In response to a question if there would be sufficient parking, Josh Wickander stated that he has talked with most of the businesses and there is not a problem since they will be closed at that time of day. They estimate about 100-150 parking spaces would be needed. He stated that if there is any cost for traffic control they would pay that cost. The owner of the shopping center has approved the event with a damage deposit.

Josh Wickander reported that he will contact the White Bear Lake Area Historical Society regarding being the sponsoring non-profit organization for the temporary liquor license. Josh Wickander stated that they stated that they would be the sponsor.

The PSC noted that their concerns are with safety and traffic. It was noted that the Township contracts with the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office for law enforcement. Josh Wickander stated that they would be happy to work with the Sheriff's Office. Josh Wickander and Commander Clark stated that they would discuss the number of deputies needed. Commander Clark noted that if for any reason there would be a problem the Sheriff's Office would end the event. It was the consensus that the PSC has no further concerns if the law enforcement requirements are worked out with the Sheriff's Office.

**NEXT MEETING DATE / ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:** The next meeting will be on Thursday, April 5, 2018. Items for discussion will include: 1) Township Day Event participation; 2) Liaison Reports; 3) Continue discussion regarding rental properties.

**OPEN TIME:** It was noted that "Hot Dog with a Deputy" is scheduled for Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> at Polar Lakes Park. It was suggested that attending PSC members wear their name tags.

LeBlanc moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Linn seconded. Ayes all.






