The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Anderson, LeBlanc, Lee, Linn, Timmers; Town Board Liaison: Ruzek; Staff Liaison: Short.

Absent: Brueckner with notice and Griffin and Pozzini-Stedman.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA (Additions/Deletions): LeBlanc moved approval of the agenda as submitted. Linn seconded. Ayes all.

APPROVAL OF JUNE 7, 2018 MINUTES (Additions/Deletions): LeBlanc moved approval of the June 7, 2018 Minutes. Linn seconded. Ayes all.

CONSENT AGENDA: LeBlanc moved approval of the Consent Agenda as follows: 4A) Receive Animal Control Reports; 4B) Receive Ramsey County Sheriff's Reports; 4C) Receive Sheriff's Contract Group Minutes; 4D) Receive White Bear Lake Fire Department Report. Linn seconded. Ayes all.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT – TOWN BOARD ACTION: **Speed Limit – Bald Eagle Avenue:** Radar speed signs have been placed on Bald Eagle Avenue. Some like it and some do not, but the neighbors are grateful for the Town's initiative. **Camp Bow Wow:** A request has been received for approval to locate a Camp Bow Wow at 4843 White Bear Parkway. The facility will provide day daycare and boarding for dogs. The applicants currently own a Camp Bow Wow in Burnsville. The request is being reviewed by the Planning Commission who will provide a recommendation to the Town Board. **Maker Space:** A request has been received for operating a "maker space" business in the Zappa Sporting Goods location on Highway 61. The building has been vacant and for sale for two years. The Maker Space concept is to provide space for members to work on wood working or other craft projects. Use for the facility is by membership only. **Ramsey County Sheriff's Office:** The Sheriff's Office is adding another investigator. The Town will receive a 4.17% increase in the Town's budget for Ramsey County Sheriff's Office services. **Animal Control:** There is a lower cost for service for 2019 due to corrections made in the accounting methods.

NIGHT TO UNITE – REVIEW: The members went to the various parties in two groups. It was suggested that prior to the event the PSC view the list and attend the larger parties. The hand-outs were good! Some hosts put the handouts in a bucket for people to take.

TOWNSHIP DAY PARTICIPATION – BIKE GIVE-AWAY: The bike being provided for the silent auction for the Township Day event cost \$750.00 (\$600.00 for the bike and \$150.00 for accessories – helmet, lock and tire pump). The bike is gender neutral. The Fire Department will provide smoke detectors and fire suppression devices for stoves. It was the consensus that someone should be available at the tent all day. The members can sign up for shifts.

RENTAL HOUSING: The Clerk reported that he talked with the Town Attorney and the Town's Building Inspector regarding rental housing. The Building Inspector noted that he gets involved with the same small numbers of properties over and over again. An issue is how to compensate

the Township for his time and how to collect fees for multiple rental housing violations and police calls. A question was asked if the Ramsey County Sheriff's Office could focus on rental properties that are a cause for concern. The Town Attorney looked at the statute but he needs to know what the PSC wants. He will review the statute further once he knows what is needed. It was the consensus to have the Town Attorney attend a PSC meeting and discuss rental housing violations and what can be done to better control rental housing. There was discussion about whether a property owner may give their right of enforcement over a lease to a municipality. It was the consensus that the property owner needs to be responsible and that if there is a fine attached to violations the behavior may improve. The Town Attorney will provide information regarding the language in the statute and see if there is some way to use authority within the statute to do what the PSC would like to see done.

The PSC will identify specific things as examples for the Town Attorney.

ANNUAL TOUR – DISCUSS LOCATION: It was the consensus that a tour of the Township scheduled this year. A tour was provided several years ago but there have been some new developments in the Town. The bus tour was agreed upon in view of the Clerk's retirement and to take the opportunity of his familiarity with the Township. The tour will be held on Thursday, October, 4, 2018. The members will convene at the Township Administrative Offices at 5:00 p.m.

LIAISON REPORTS: Fire Department: The Fire Department will have a new ambulance before the end of the year. A new truck with heavier chassis is also being added. Six full time paramedics will be hired to fill out the crews.

NEXT MEETING DATE / ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION: The next regularly scheduled PSC meeting will be Thursday, October 4, 2018 for the annual tour. The November meeting will be Thursday, November 1, 2018. Katie Engman, Minnesota Tobacco Coalition and the Town Attorney will attend the meeting (for different topics).

OPEN TIME: No one appeared for the open portion of the meeting.

Linn moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 p.m. LeBlanc seconded. Ayes all.


We had another great evening for our TFA Surveys. CAO's volunteering this evening were Jean Fenstad, Bob Fischer and Carolann Martin.

We started out the evening with 14 people gathered at the Public Works Building for a meeting that was to be conducted by Ramsey County Parks & Recreation regarding the land development in Arden Hills. The building was locked and I went inside to check if anyone was there and no one was present.

The residents had already attempted to call Parks & Recreation and the City of Arden Hills thinking that the meeting had been moved. No success reaching anyone. They had a postcard indicating that tonight was to be the third open forum meeting to be conducted at this location and none had received a phone call or email indicating that it was cancelled. One of the residents there was also one of our CERT members. Jean, Bob and I struck up a conversation with them and many had NTU gatherings and thanked the Sheriff's Office for coming out that night and appreciated all of our efforts. They were all in good spirits when they left and they were going to follow up with the Parks and Recreation Department on Thursday morning.


- When we arrived at Market Place Mall we touched base with seven of the businesses raising awareness to our presence in the parking lot and left one of our brochures at each business. Some of the other businesses were already closed.
- Many good conversations with people indicating that they liked what we were doing.
- At the end of the evening, all three of us stood and chatted with a resident that was a retired Minneapolis police officer. It all started when he was exiting his vehicle and locked it with his remote and Bob indicated that his back windows were still open. The resident laughed and closed the windows and that led to a great conversation for about 10 minutes.
- One gentleman had a lot to say about the country and politicians and spoke to Bob for about 15 to 20 minutes. Bob did a great job of listening.
- Another gentleman gave the brochure back to Jean from his car and indicated that he doesn't collect those.

We surveyed 121 vehicles and spoke to 22 people at Market Place Mall this evening. Below are the updated numbers for our four TFA survey events this season totaling 576 vehicles surveyed and 102 conversations with people.



These great kids also earned an 80% tip on the bill from Commander Ramacher, who noted the excellent service and cool cup and straw.



Not to be outdone by the proud parents in our communities, several of our School Resource Officers (SROs) got in on the "First Day of School" photo action earlier this month.



It was all a part of the NBPA's annual back to school backpack and school supply giveaway that treats kids to free haircuts, hygiene kits, and new backpacks.


Sharing a Slice of "Lake Life"



The takeaway from all of this?

For emergencies, issues that need immediate police response, or to report crimes or suspicious activity, don’t post, DO call.

- **DO call 651-767-0640 for non-emergencies in Ramsey County**
