
1st Qtr Total Stops







Bill,

I don't make a habit of responding to correspondents in anger, though this issue touches my heart. I am unbelievably disappointed and disgusted in the resistance shown to a safety concern.

I am well aware of the hoops and legalities involved in government as you know and find it shameful that this issue is being set aside with so little justification and yet such a tremendous upside. Its the very nature of public safety to be proactive, not reactive. Daily I work to assist individuals and communities in local and state government to make proactive decisions for public health and well-being. I wouldn't dream of waiting to react until after the worse case scenario and neither should you.

I want to be crystal clear at this point; while I appreciate Mikes involvement the speed of traffic had and continues to have zero bearing on my concern which I've made clear over and over. A vehicle traveling at a legal speed could not stop soon enough to avoid hitting a suddenly appearing child.

I have the support of my neighbors, I've offered to pay out of pocket... neighborhood demographics change, traffic patterns change... your group resistance to this is simply put, irresponsible.

I am telling you that I observe daily dangerous situations, I am glad you drove past the intersection but do not disregard my warnings or observations. I live here Bill, what more could you ask for than a constant observer? What exactly are you seeing that so disqualifies my observations?

I have made you well aware of what I am seeing and have kept record of each denial. I will promise you at this point that if a child, animal, adult etc. should be struck that a driver will almost certainly say "I could not see them in time"... which is exactly the problem! I will pursue legal action against each individual who refuses to address the situation having been made so vividly aware of it.

I have removed all reasonable explanations for you to not take a proactive step towards safety. You have sited repeatedly a speed study which again was never my concern or you have explained that you would have to put a sign on all three corners, or that the township doesn't "like" to put up new signs.... I do not care, those are not justifiable reasons to not act.

Spend a day in my shoes and watch one fedex truck crest that hill staring at a GPS unit and it will send a shiver up your spine.

I suggest at this point that your team either:

A.) re-evaluate the intersection and think proactively (there is no reason not to do this Bill... not one).

Or B.) get a lawyer because I will not let this issue go.

Let me meet the decision makers face to face so they can personally justify putting my children and those of my neighbors at risk when I've offered to pay for a stop sign. Children who were not born when the intersection was created (when 3 houses existed on my street, my own home being the 2nd house built).

It is their consensus that, based on the Traffic Deputy recommendation and their on-site tour, a stop sign is not warranted.

I will still meet with our Public Works Director to identify any areas that need tree trimming.

I expressed to the Board and Commission your sincere concern for the safety of children in your neighborhood and they are genuinely sensitive to it. But, they do not agree that adding the stop is the proper way to address it.

I would be glad to discuss it with you further.



Short summary of request

In February 2015, during a Health and Safety Commission meeting the members determined they would like to prepare the community for potential natural disaster. Suggestion to seek donations for Disaster Readiness Bags was brought to the City Council in March 2015. Commission members applied for donations and grants to purchase bags and non-battery-operated flashlights.

Purpose and Goal of Disaster Readiness Bag:

Disaster Aware, Take Action to Prepare Bags was based on the fact disasters disrupt hundreds of thousands of lives every year. After a disaster, local responders may not be able to reach everyone immediately and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) warns that every citizen should be ready to be self-sufficient for at least three days. An important part of FEMA's "Be Disaster Aware, Take Action to Prepare" and the Red Cross campaign "Are You Ready?" is to make sure every family has an emergency kit in their home to help them survive after a disaster. Our goal is the same: make sure every household in Vadnais Heights is prepared for a disaster.

how the requested money will be spent : The Vadnais Heights Health and Public Safety Commission will use money to purchase an item for the Disaster Readiness Bags. Thus far, we have provided: Hand crank flashlight, mini first aid kit, whistle, and hand sanitizers. In 2019 we would like to provide:

What will be done and by whom: The money provided will be used to purchase a product to be distributed at Nite to Unite and community events like Lions Waffle Breakfast or Taste of Vadnais.

Start and end date of project: The start date for this event will be the first Tuesday in August 2019-Nite to Unite. The end date will be when we run out of product.

Expected impact of the project and how it will benefit the community: The goal of the City of Vadnais Heights Health and Public Safety Commission is to provide an item listed on the Disaster Readiness Bag-initially distributed in 2015 in an effort to create community and family preparedness for a disaster, with the ultimate goal of an ongoing campaign to keep Vadnais Heights citizens aware of and ready for any disaster.

Describe criteria for evaluating the project's success: During Nite to Unite, you will hear conversations around what the family may have done to prepare, from simply hanging their bag in garage to closet in lower level of home to listening to the kids chat about where they are to go, if tornado strikes or in an event of a home fire, where they as a family will meet. Community remembering what they received the year before.
