The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Anderson, Brueckner, Griffin, LeBlanc, Lee, Pozzini-Stedman; Advisor: Christopherson; Town Board Supervisor: McCune.

Absent: Linn with Notice

APPROVAL OF AGENDA (Additions/Deletions): LeBlanc moved approval of the agenda as submitted. Brueckner seconded. Ayes all.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JUNE 6, 2019 (Additions/Deletions): Brueckner moved to approve the Minutes of June 6, 2019. LeBlanc seconded. Ayes all.

CONSENT AGENDA: LeBlanc moved to receive the Consent Agenda as follows: A) Receive Animal Control Reports; B) Receive Ramsey County Sheriff's Reports; C) Receive Sheriff's Contract Group Minutes; D) Receive White Bear Lake Fire Department Report. Anderson seconded. Ayes all.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: Town Board Supervisor McCune was present to report on important decisions the Board has been discussing and making. The **Pavement Management Plan** for 2019 is underway, and because it is late in the season, the Board is already discussing 2020's planning so as to start earlier in the season. **Budget Planning**, the Board is adjusting some of the budget so as to stay below the levy amount voted by the residents in March 2019. The Board will approve the preliminary budget at the second Town Board Meeting in September, with Full approval in December. McCune gave a brief summary of **Nuisance Ordinance Request** made by the Board for the Public Safety Commission to think about and adopt an ordinance regarding nuisance residences in the Township. There will be more information at the agenda item and at following meetings.

Water Gremlin has been in the news. The Board is trying to respond in the best possible way, however, the main authority figures when it comes to Water Gremlin are the Minnesota Department of Health and the Pollution Control Agency. As Public Safety Commissioners, it was brought up what their response should be if asked by residents. McCune explained that the Board is looking into it and have talked a lot about it. The Town Clerk stated that the Township's authority is pre-empted by the State, the MDH, and the PCA. In this regard, the Board has been hesitant to be out in front because it doesn't want to make things worse for residents or cause alarm in other ways. It was stated that the Township doesn't have anything to do with Water Gremlin's faults; it's the State's concern. The Township doesn't have say into who runs a business within the limits of the Township or what the business does. Solely the Township has say over Ordinances, Variances, requests for Conditional Use Permits and such when expanding, etc. It was noted that the Township is under no obligation to make a statement, however, Staff want to because they owe it to the residents. There was discussion regarding the concern of impact on quality of health. The epidemiological study showed no correlation. It was noted that Water Gremlin looks worse and worse with each new media coverage. There was discussion of how Water Gremlin brings quality 200-300 jobs to the Township. It was mentioned that back a couple years there was a newspaper article praising Water Gremlin for

being a good neighbor to residents in the Township, and the grounds are always maintained and even beautiful.

TOWNSHIP DAY – LISA BEECROFT, TOWNSHIP DAY COORDINATOR, TO ATTEND:

Beecroft was present to report on the finalizations of the Township Day festivities. She gave a brief intro of herself and what Beecroft Marketing and Events does. It was noted that she loves interacting with the community and she is glad to be able to honor the previous coordinator's legacy. She thanked the Public Safety Commission for their contribution to the silent auction, and explained that next year she will attend a Public Safety Meeting in the early planning stages and a meeting right before Township Days.

Beecroft went over the Bands that will be playing, how this year she added a second stage for the kids. She went over the agenda from pages 179 to 184 and then was present to answer questions. She also noted that she was in charge of the Movies in the Park and how there were anywhere from 40 to 140 people in attendance. There was a question on whether or not Beecroft found someone to sing the National Anthem. She explained the other applicant had left the Township school district and currently resides in Hugo. For this matter, she brought it up to the White Bear Lake School district and some of the WBL Choir members will sing.

When Township Day was searched at the meeting on a mobile device it came up right away, so the Search Engine Optimization is paying off. There was discussion of the silent auction, parking, and the Public Safety Commission booth. Beecroft told the Commission it will be the same as last year with the Banner, table, chairs, awning, etc. that Public Works will set up. There was discussion of volunteering and if any Commissioners want to volunteer they just have to email Beecroft.

NIGHT TO UNITE – REVIEW: The Public Safety Commission discussed the parties they had gone to and discussions they had had with residents. It was noted that some were concerned by Margaret and Whitaker stop sign with folks not stopping; Parkway drivers driving over the speed limit; and Fisher had asked for more patrol in that area. There was discussion of some other parties, among which was Jan Timmers' legacy that her brother continued. He hosted and thanked everyone for the years of fun memories. Her van was still there.

NUISANCE ORDINANCE – UPDATE: The Town Clerk reported that the Town Attorney is back working on the project of going through all the Town's ordinances and is working on a new and improved ordinance recommendation list. Public Safety is asked to consider helping with creating a nuisance ordinance.

WATCH FOR CHILDREN SIGN REQUEST – GARDEN LANE: The Commission discussed the potential implications of having a Watch for Children sign at Garden Lane. There was discussion of the Deaf Child sign. The sign had been there for years, who checks in on those signs? Are they current? Who is in charge of looking into these scenarios? Other questions were brought up and discussed. It was the consensus that the Town Clerk will follow-up on the Deaf Child sign and there will be more discussion next meeting.

ANNUAL TOUR – DISCUSS LOCATION: The Commission discussed previous years' annual tours. A few locations were discussed from previous years like the gun simulation, Lake Elmo airport, highway helicopters, the detention center, local businesses, Ramsey County Courthouse, Lino Lakes Fire Department, and others. It was the consensus that the Commission will think of ideas and will get back to the Town Clerk. The tour will be scheduled shortly.

LIAISON REPORTS: Rich Brueckner reported that Otter Lake Elementary School students are back, he had spoken with Cynthia the Principal via telephone on Tuesday, September 3rd, 2019. He advised her that the Public Safety Commission won't be participating at the carnival this year. He also gave the Chair's contact to Cynthia as Brueckner spends the winters south.

Connie Anderson reported that the new fire White Bear Lake Fire Engine got crashed into by a pickup truck in the middle of traffic. The crash caused a decent amount of damage, resulting in the truck being sent to Wisconsin to get fixed.

NEXT MEETING DATE / ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION: The next Public Safety Commission Meeting will be held on October 3rd, 2019 and the tour will be held/discussed.

OPEN TIME: No one appeared for the open portion of the meeting.

ADDED AGENDA ITEMS: The Town Board Supervisor had inquired of why the Public Safety Commission did not want to discuss Tobacco 21 any further. The Commissioners explained that with the City being so close in proximity, it doesn't sound practical for the Township if the City doesn't change their ordinance on tobacco. It was noted that 44 communities in the state support Tobacco 21, as do 18 communities in the metro area. The Commission wants to wait until this agenda item is decided upon at a state level. The Town Clerk noted that White Bear Lake will not approve of Tobacco 21.

LeBlanc moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:25 p.m. Brueckner seconded. Ayes all.

- 218 PARTIES – 207 parties visited by RCSO
- Additional funding of RCSO Night to Unite activities is provided by grants/donations received from organizations in the communities served. These funds, coordinated through the 501c non-profit Ramsey County Sheriff's Foundation, of approximately \$8,000 are used to augment the \$5,000 provided by the Contract.
- Donations earmarked for the Night to Unite efforts coordinated by the Crime Prevention Unit have included \$5,000 from the Land O' Lakes Foundation, \$2,000 from Boston Scientific, and monies raised by the Sheriff's Foundation. Previous years we have also received monetary support from Target Corporation and other area businesses. This year we again received non-cash assistance from Target through the loan of shopping carts to help the movement of supplies/donations/etc. We also received non-cash assistance from the City of


