

Notice

Most of the proposed 2020 Street Improvements project will take place within a 16-60 foot right of way. Items in the existing Right of Way, including flowers, sprinklers, landscaping, and irrigation systems and other items affected by the construction will be removed by the contractor. Property owners may want to relocate these items onto their property prior to the start of construction as removals will become property of the contractor.

SPRINKLERS

If a sprinkler system is installed near the edge of the existing roadway, it may be in jeopardy. If it lies within 3 to 5 feet of the existing roadway it will likely be removed. Please mark your sprinkler heads to avoid any unnecessary troubles.

PARKING

Temporary "No Parking" signs have been placed throughout the neighborhood as a reminder of no street parking during construction hours between 7 am and 7 pm. It is requested that residents park elsewhere between these hours to avoid any conflicts with equipment and machinery performing road work.

RIGHT OF ENTRY FORMS

If you received a Right Of Entry notice, please fill out this form and return. Due to narrow right of way on multiple streets in this area, the contractor may need a few extra feet of room beyond the right of way to be able to slope yards and driveways to the back of the new proposed concrete curb. These can be given to the Construction Inspector whose name is listed in the contact information on this form. If you have questions, the construction inspector is able to answer them for you.

LANDSCAPING

Any landscaping placed behind the edge of existing roadway will be affected by the construction. It is suggested property owners relocate any landscaping they want to save and place back after construction. Any landscaping that does not get relocated may be removed by the contractor and replaced with sod during restoration. If you are unsure if you have landscaping that will be affected, please call the construction inspector to have those questions answered.


CONCRETE CURB PLACEMENT

New concrete curb and gutter is proposed as part of this street improvement project. Once the concrete curb starts to be placed there will be no parking allowed on your street for 7 days. This is to allow the concrete to strengthen and avoid damage to the curb after it is placed.
